Digital Forensics & Data Analytics Enables comparative analysis of investigations and operations.


 Capture data from digital sources such as servers, emails, docs, SMS, WhatsApp, Facebook, browser, etc.

 Analyse and process collected data into actionable information for use in the investigation process.



Integrity Due Diligence Platform

- Designed to take in program & project data with input from external sources to detect potential Red Flags.
- Proactively informs stakeholders of potentials risks and provide opportunities for the IIU intervene early when Red Flags are detected.








