

- Nov 20 Deadline for initial expression of interest » Three countries responded
- Nov 25 Guidelines mailed to the three candidates
- Jan 8 Deadline for submission of formal planning paper
- Jan Feb Comparative assessment of received papers

Mar 2010 Final selection



Application Criteria to be the Host Country

- (1) Send invitation from the head of government to the other 49 heads of government in the Asia-Pacific region.
- (2) The host government is expected to bear a majority of the costs involved in hosting the event.
- (3) The host government is expected to host the APWS as an independent event.



Planning Paper (Deadline January 8th, 2010)

- (1) Financial matters
 - Cost estimates & estimated revenues
- (2) Safety and Security
 - Overall infrastructure, including police security
- (3) Logistical and Technical Issues
 - Host city, dates, venue, hotels, transportation
- (4) Commitment and Support
 - Highest political and national leadership



Selection Process 3/3


APWF Governing Council

- Provides guidance to the formation of the candidate assessment criteria
- Makes final decision on the host country, host city and the venue by consensus

2nd APWS Working Group

Evaluates each candidate proposal based on the assessment criteria and provides a report to the APWF Governing Council


